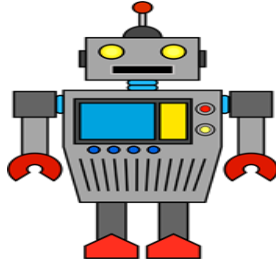
Tiny Picassos

STEM-U – Coding with Ollie

STEM-U will teach kids block programming using Ollie. The Ollie is an app enabled robot that we use to engage kids in programming!! The Ollie is controlled via a simple drag and drop programming interface. Our philosophy is to use play to engage kids in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) activities. In this class, we provide students a variety of fun challenges and competitive activities that must be accomplished by programming the robot. Kids are eager to make the robot do various cool things that we can easily introduce the basics of programming like functions, loops, conditional statements. By implementing various functions using the drag and drop programming interface kids can immediately see the outcome. This makes the abstract process of programming and engaging in computational thinking very concrete for students, and provides visible as well as fun ways for students to see the application of STEM. The class integrates math concepts, engineering construction, and control of the robot's sensors in its challenges.

The course content will appeal to girls as well as boys. The challenges and activities are structured as beginner, intermediate, and advanced allowing us to work with various grade and experience levels. Children will work in pairs to build sense of teamwork, collaboration, and accomplishment. No previous programming experience is necessary. If you know drag and drop programming already or have taken a Coding with Sphero or Ollie class you can still join this class. Our activities will be different and are not repeated up to 2 years. STEM-U provides all the materials including the Ollie robots and tablets.
